

## GEM LAKES RECREATION AREA RULES

1. No dogs or other pets allowed in the recreation area at any time
2. No children under 12 years of age are allowed recreation privileges unless accompanied by an adult. (Lifeguard is not regraded as a qualifying adult.)
3. Guests are welcome only with a resident member host.
4. Only three (3) guests per homeowner family allowed unless approved by the board.
5. Absolutely no fishing in the swimming area or off the dock.
6. All litter must be placed in trash containers.
7. No glass bottles or glass containers on the beach area or in the water.
8. Maximum 15 mph speed limit on road leading to recreation area.
9. Motor vehicles including motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles (ATV) are restricted to the main entrance road. No gasoline-powered motor boats allowed on the lakes.
10. No parking of cars, motorcycles, or ATVs except in the parking lot.
11. No parking of vehicles in front of main gate when gate is closed, or in front of gate to the beach area.
12. No firearms, including but not limited to, B-B and pellet guns, permitted on the Association property.
13. Lake and recreation hours are from 10 am to 8 pm, Monday-Sunday.
14. No rowdiness, lewdness, or other ill-mannered conduct on the Association property is permitted.
15. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the beach area. You must be of legal age to consume alcoholic beverages on the rest of the Association property.
16. No homeowner is authorized to change, move, relocate, or alter any Association property without the president's expressed consent, except in the case of emergency.
17. Failure to observe GLRA rules will result in suspension of GLRA privileges for a period of time
18. S.C. law, Section 33-31-100 (3) gives a non-profit association the right to expel or suspend membership privileges of a member. Any member violating these rules will have their membership privileges suspended by the directors, unless extenuating circumstances are present. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children and will have their membership privileges suspended if their children violate these rules.
