

RULES FOR USE OF THE GEM LAKES RECREATION ASSOCIATION PAVILION

General Rules

- ◆ Dues must be current
- ◆ Only Gem Lakes residents can reserve the pavilion area
- ◆ No swimming without a lifeguard
- ◆ Park only in an approved area
- ◆ No loud music
- ◆ Clean up after your party
- ◆ Children 12 years and under need to be supervised by an adult

Prior To Use

1. A \$50.00 deposit is required prior to obtaining keys. All of this deposit will be refunded if:
 - * an inspection to check clean-up has been completed and
 - * no complaints have been issued by surrounding residents concerning the rental party

During Use

2. The gate at the top of the hill may be opened to drive vehicles to the shelter area for unloading and loading of supplies only. (***Do not drive on the grass.***) If the main gate needs to be opened, it is to be locked open using the cable on the tree and the gate lock. Extreme caution must be used when driving up and down the driveway, as it is primarily a pedestrian walkway.
3. All vehicles from the rental party must be parked in the main parking lot.
4. No loud music! This is a residential area. Music played in the pavilion area can be heard all around the lake, and loud music is not appreciated by the local residents. As noted above, if there are any complaints from residents, your deposit may be forfeited.
5. No swimming is allowed unless a certified lifeguard is on duty. If the area is to be reserved before or after the normal swimming season, those reserving the area must obtain the services of a certified lifeguard if the swimming area is to be utilized. Johnny Spears has a list of the lifeguards available for hire.
6. According to D.H.E.C. for every 25 people, a lifeguard is needed. If your party is for 75 people, three guards are needed. One is provided, the other two would be paid at their current hourly rate by those using the pavilion. (*We cannot assume that only 20 people will be swimming.*)
7. All trash must be collected and placed in the dumpster in the main lot after use of the facility.
8. Ensure that all fires have been put out and that the water is turned off.
9. Make sure that all gates are closed and locked.
10. The new bathrooms were built for your convenience, so please check before and after your party to make sure they are clean, no vandalism has taken place, and the doors are locked when you leave.
