

PICKLEBALL/TENNIS COURT RULES

COURT RULES

- Guests are welcome only with Association member host.
- Only the playing of pickleball or tennis are allowed on courts; therefore, skateboards, bikes, roller blades, skates, etc. are prohibited.
- Only tennis/court shoes allowed on courts.
- Upon completion of a pickleball match, all portable nets should be returned, along with ball barrier nets, to the fence adjacent to the culdesac. Loosen the velcro on each end of the net allowing the nets to droop which will preserve the nets. Brakes on each end of the frame should be locked.
- No food or drink are allowed on playing surfaces; however, may be consumed at the fence area only.
- Do not move white seating benches onto the playing surfaces.
- Please remove any trash from the courts and dispose of it properly.
- Do not remove/destroy any bag holders attached to the fence – they are there for the purpose of hanging bags.
- Upon completion of game, ensure both gates have been locked.

CODE OF CONDUCT/SAFETY RULES

- Players limited to one hour if other players are waiting to play.
- No player will engage in unsportsmanlike conduct.
- The use of obscene language or gestures are not permitted.
- Any behavior that endangers the health and safety of others is not permitted
- If you are crossing an active court to get onto a vacant court or to leave a court, wait until the current point is over. Ask for permission to cross the court.
- If a ball breaks, remove it from the court and dispose it properly.
- If someone falls on the court, all play STOPS IMMEDIATELY, until their needs are addressed.
- Never play on a wet court. They are extremely dangerous and it degrades the court surface.
- Look out for your fellow players.

South Carolina Law, Section 33-31-100 (3), gives a non-profit association the right to expel or suspend membership privileges of a member. Any member violating these rules will have their membership privileges suspended by the directors unless extenuating circumstances are present. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children and will have their membership privileges suspended if their children violate these rules.
